Motion by Metzger/Yaeger to recommend to Council to award the Limestone Contract to MCC at a price of \$6.15 a ton for both ¾" and 1 ½". Voice vote. Motion carried.

Motion by Brockhaus/Johnson to recommend to Council to award the Fuel Contract to Coonen's Clintonville Shell) at a price of .06 per gallon for both regular unleaded and diesel fuel. Voice vote. Motion carried.

McCord informed the Committee that Availability has been working for a couple of weeks in the Industrial Park area. He stated that they have 400 to 500 feet of sanitary sewer in the ground and considering the weather and time of year they are working well. McCord said they are company that has not done work her previous so the City did some pre-qualifications and reference checks and stated that he is very pleased with their work so far.
