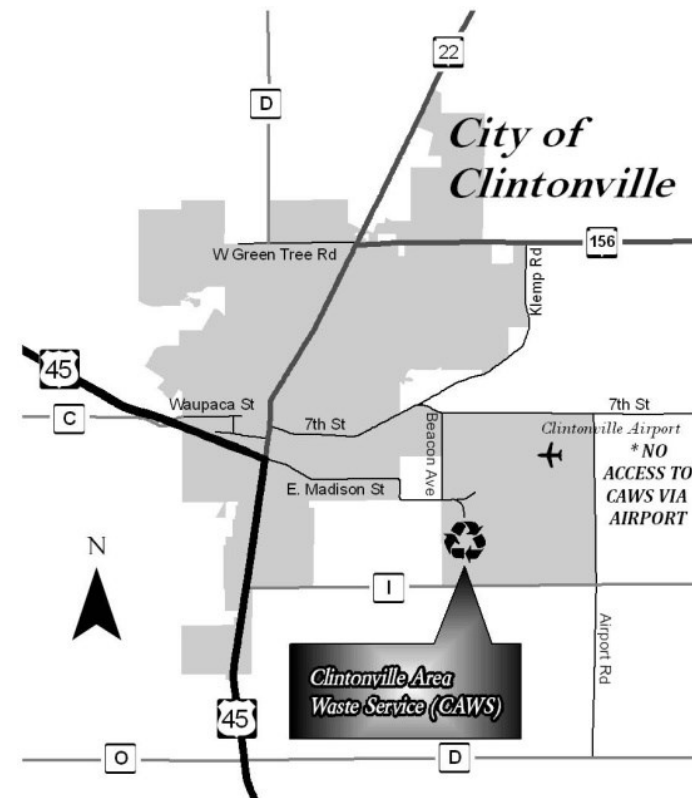

CAWS Disposal Fees

GARBAGE 2.50

- In a clear plastic bag
- 35 gallon size or smaller bag

WASTE not in bags will be charged by ESTIMATED volume and weight

DEMOLITION WASTE must be weighed at a local scale and will be charged \$0.05 per pound according to the weight slip from the scale.

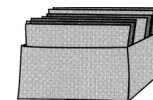

MIXED PAPER AND CARDBOARD

- Catalogs, boxboard (cereal & Kleenex boxes), junk mail, magazines, phone books, shredded paper, corrugated cardboard
- Flatten boxes; cut boxes down to 3 ft x 3 ft
- **NO** hardcover books or spiral notebooks
- **NO** food-contaminated paper



USED MOTOR OIL FEE OF \$0.25/GALLON

- Brake fluid, engine - hydraulic - transmission oil
- **DO NOT** mix anything with waste motor oil
- **NO** antifreeze, brake cleaner, gasoline



YARD WASTE

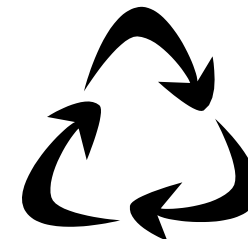
- Leaves, grass, pine needles, brush
- Place in compost area outside of recycling area. Compost area is open 24/7.
- **DO NOT** put yard waste in your garbage bags



Wisconsin's

Recycling Law

Wisconsin's Recycling Law requires all of the items listed on these two pages (along with tires, appliances, vehicle batteries, oil filters, and electronics) be separated from garbage to be reused or recycled. These items cannot be disposed of in landfills.



CAWS RECYCLES!

CAWS Recycling Information

ALUMINUM CANS

- Rinse, flatten if possible
- Includes aluminum pet food cans



STEEL CANS (including paint & aerosol cans)

- Rinse, flatten if possible
- Paint & aerosol cans must be empty and dry, lids removed



GLASS BOTTLES & JARS (food & beverage)

- Rinse, remove caps & lids
- Recycle metal lids with steel cans
- Sort by 3 colors: (1) Clear, (2) Brown/Yellow, (3) Green/Blue
- **NO** windows, mirrors, light bulbs, oven-ware, ceramics, perfume bottles, dishes, drinking glasses, candle holders, or any other non-container glass



PLASTIC BOTTLES & CONTAINERS

- Rinse, remove & discard screw caps
- **Plastic Bottles:** soda, water, milk, other food & drink, detergent, shampoo cleansers, etc.
- **Produce, Bakery & Deli Containers:** berry, donut, dips, potato salad, etc.
- **Dairy Containers & Lids:** yogurt, margarine, cottage cheese, sour cream, etc.
- **NO** motor oil, solvent, or pesticide bottles
- **NO** plastic bags
- **NO** foam cups/trays, plastic ware, toys, flower pots, laundry baskets, etc.



NEWSPAPER (without color inserts)

- Place in cattle trailer next to mixed paper & cardboard dumpsters
- Place colored inserts with mixed paper



VEHICLE BATTERIES 5.00

OIL FILTERS 0.25 each

USED MOTOR OIL 0.25 per gallon

PAINT HARDENER 2.50 per bag

For use with Latex paint ONLY

Product solidifies approx. 2/3 gallon of latex paint within 30 minutes. Solidified latex paint can then be disposed of in the trash.

CANNOT BE USED ON OIL PAINTS OR STAINS

(see *Hazardous Waste* below)



HAZARDOUS WASTE (fee)

Not accepted at the CAWS site.

Hazardous waste must be properly disposed of through the Waupaca County Household Hazardous Waste program, by appointment May through October, at the **Waupaca County PTF**.

ELECTRONICS (fee)

Not accepted at the CAWS site.

TVs, computers, computer components, printers, fax machines, laptops, VCRs, DVD players, and cell phones, can no longer be disposed of in the trash. The above electronics can be taken to the **Waupaca County PTF** for recycling.

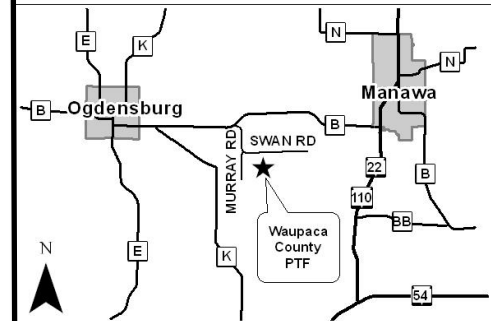
